Our YMCA has been awarded an \$870,000 grant to serve the community of Southward Village. The Y will increase access and participation in high-quality extended learning opportunities by enrolling school age children in out-of-school time activities decreasing chronic absenteeism. Children will also have access to YMCA Safety Around Water lessons to ensure children in the community learn the skills needed to stay safe in and around water.

Collaborations and partnerships make it possible for our Y to ensure that all have access to our programs. We can go beyond our walls and serve those who need the Y the most. I extend my utmost gratitude to every partner and donor who has joined our movement and makes this possible each day.
