
to building strong kids to be a part of a strong community.

HOW TO REGISTER!

1. Online

You can register directly though our website!

- Go to www.YMCASWFL.org homepage.
- Click on programs, then
 Online Program Registration
- Select a location
- Select day camp
- Select a camp!
- Follow prompt to create username or enter your username to move to checkout.
- Day camp registration requires a \$30 registration fee.
- A non-refundable deposit of \$25 will be due at registration per child per week.

2. At the Branch

Visit your local Y branch to pick up a full registration packet.

- Written cancellation made at least 15 days before start of camp will be given a full refund minus the non-refundable deposit and registration fee!
- Cancellations made within

 20% processing fee.

SPECIALTY CAMPS (ALL BRANCHES)

Campers develop a greater passion for the things they love or try out something new! We have something to keep them smiling all week long. At each YMCA Specialty Camp, day campers spend approximately two hours of each day in their specialized activity, with the remainder of the day spent enjoying Traditional Camp activities.

SPORTS CAMPS (ALL BRANCHES)

These camps offer a fun-filled sports environment with an emphasis on team work, sportsmanship and basic fundamentals. Part of the day will be spent on your camper's sport focus where they will focus on stretching, warm-ups, skill and drills, educational games and scrimmages. For the rest of the day, campers will experience all the other great activities the YMCA has to offer. Campers will create their next masterpiece in arts and crafts, explore nature and science, possibly take a dip in the pool and so much more.



SPORTS ACADEMY (VENICE & ENGLEWOOD)

Sports Academy offers the next level of sports instruction for your budding athlete. The majority of the day will be spent warming up, honing skills through drills, playing developmental games and scrimmaging. AQUATIC CAMPS (BS, LR, BB, V, & E)

Have fun and keep cool this summer! YMCA Aquatic Camps are perfect for children of all ages. Each camper will spend at least two session blocks in the pool participating in a daily lesson, aquatic games and free swim, learning an important life skill. Campers are swim tested daily and placed in color-coded groups based on age and ability.



GYMNASTICS (VENICE)

Gymnastics programs at the YMCA range from classes and summer camps to competitive team. Learn and refine basic skills, improve your balance and coordination while gaining self-esteem. Practice bars, side handstands, beam routines, cartwheels and more. Gymnastics Camps are offered from 5 years and up.



Travel Camps take to the road with a combination of exciting field trips and activities in our camp facilities. Campers will enjoy new experiences by taking trips every day. Our trained camp counselors help to ensure every day is safe and supervised, so parents can rest easy knowing their young ones are in a secure environment. Trip destinations can include, but are not limited to, roller and ice-skating, historical destinations, indoor and outdoor amusement parks, pizza and movie day, swim destinations and much more.



KINDER CAMP (BS, FR & VENICE)

Kindergarten Readiness Camp is designed to help children have a fun camp experience while also helping them get better prepared for the start of their academic career. This camp is full of enriching activities but designed for the little ones. Each weekly session allows for exploration and individual learning opportunities. Little campers will unplug, enjoy hands-on learning, build and learn new skills and make new friends. Our weekly activities include STEAM, sports and games, art and songs. 
