### **WATER SAFETY STARTS WITH YOU:** PHONES DOWN, EYES UPTM

Drowning is fast, silent—and preventable. This summer, YMCA of Southwest Florida is raising awareness through our commitment to water safety and the national Phones Down, Eyes Up™ campaign.

Don't miss our powerful video segment featuring YMCA Board Member Libby Soberberg and Association Director of Aquatics Cassy Velarde, as they share the Y's critical work to keep kids safe around water. They break down how you can get your child into swim lessons and why staying alert—especially around pools, lakes and beaches—is lifesaving.



These everyday actions only take seconds—but so does drowning. 88% of child drownings happen with at least one adult present. That's why we encourage all families to assign a Water Watcher: a designated, sober adult with no distractions, whose only focus is supervising children in and around water.
