



## SKY ACADEMY ENGLEWOOD: LAUNCHING LEARNING TO NEW HEIGHTS



Learning came alive in a powerful way when students at SKY Academy Englewood launched a high-altitude weather balloon as part of an immersive STEM experience.

With guidance from their eighth-grade STEM teacher and mentors from the Englewood Amateur Radio Society, students prepared a helium-filled latex balloon equipped with a lightweight payload system designed to transmit real-time atmospheric data. As the wind aligned and the moment arrived, students released the balloon, watching it climb rapidly into the sky.

Cheers erupted. Cameras recorded. Science became real. The balloon transmitted altitude, temperature, GPS coordinates, speed, solar data, date and time as it soared to nearly 40,000 feet. Students who had been studying gravity, atmospheric pressure and physics were suddenly witnessing those principles in action.

This hands-on project gave 63 students the opportunity to connect classroom theory to real-world application. They learned how helium expands at higher altitudes, how communication systems track location and how amateur radio operators provide essential support during emergencies.

Perhaps most importantly, they learned that technology is something to understand and master. By demystifying the digital world, students gain confidence, and that spark of curiosity can grow into future careers in engineering, aviation, meteorology, communications and beyond.



## BEACON COLLEGE TOURS: EXPANDING VISION AND OPPORTUNITY

Forty Beacon students recently visited Florida Gulf Coast University and the University of Miami, stepping onto college campuses and envisioning their futures.

For many, it was their first time walking through lecture halls, touring residence facilities and engaging with admissions staff. The experience transformed abstract ideas about “college someday” into tangible, achievable goals.

These tours are a critical step in increasing awareness of career pathways. Students begin connecting personal interests to degree programs. They ask questions about majors, internships, financial aid and campus life. They begin planning, not just dreaming.

Program Exploration becomes Career Planning.  
Career Planning becomes Goal Setting.  
Goal Setting becomes Action Planning.  
And with each step, confidence grows.

## EXPANDING ACCESS: A NEW SUMMER CAMP SITE

Through a partnership with DeSoto County, we are expanding our reach by opening a new camp location at the Turner Center in Arcadia this summer.

This site will provide safe, enriching spaces for youth to grow academically, socially and physically. From STEM enrichment to arts, physical activity, and character development, this program ensures that geography is never a barrier to opportunity.

## A NIGHT IN THE BIG APPLE: VENICE YMCA




